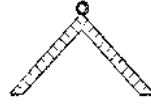

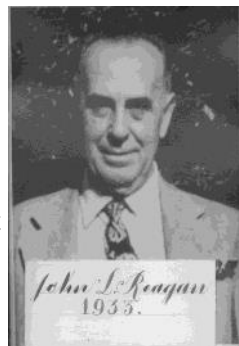

Greetings to our Masonic Family,

We at Bridgeport Lodge have been busy, and will be busy with Degree Work and various Lodge Activities throughout the remainder of the year. We welcome our new Masons into our Lodge and extend an invitation to our meetings, and events as frequently as you can attend. To our officers, we thank you for your efforts during this busy time we are in.

We have upcoming events, if possible attend these events and support your Lodge. Look for the dates in the COORDINATOR.

As we are nearing the end of the year, most of you have received your dues notice in the mail. There is another change this year the Dues Notice is again being mailed by Grand Lodge. Your dues payment will still be mailed to me as the Lodge Secretary, and I'll send the 2014 dues cards. Here is the change this year; the plastic dues card you receive for your 2014 dues will be a permanent dues card going forward for you. There will not be any new cards sent to you in the future when paying dues. Keep this one going forward.
